Open buffet breakfast & dinner will be served daily

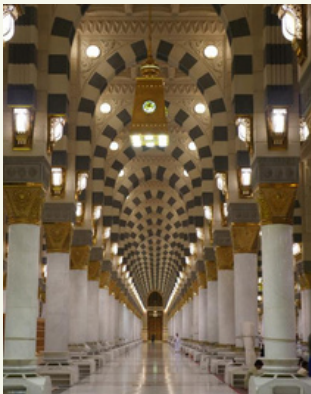

You will depart by bus to Makkah (Aziziyah)

- Please remember that you will be in the state of Ihram from Madinah.
- It is recommended that you perform your Umrah as a group under the guidance of your team leader - **Umrah schedule will be announced**

MOVEMENTS DURING THE MANASIK OF HAJJ **FROM THE 8TH TO THE 13TH OF DHUAL HIJJAH**

Please be informed that transportation arrangements during the days of Manasik of Hajj (8th DH - 13th DH) are solely managed by the Hajj Ministry. **Timings and movements are determined by the Ministry's schedule and approval.** We will provide updates on movements and timings as we receive them the day before.



FRIDAY, JUNE 14

(8th Dhul' Hijjah)

Mena

- **After Breakfast, we will proceed by bus in the state of Ihram to Mena to begin your Hajj journey, Insha'Allah.**
- You will arrive in Mena and reside until the next day to depart to Arafat by bus.
- Lunch & Dinner will be offered in Mena.
- You should value and use your time in Mena with supplication and remembrance of Allahu Subhanahu Wa Ta'ala.

Timings and movements are determined by the Ministry's schedule and approval. We will provide updates on movements and timings as soon as we receive them.

DAY
09

SATURDAY, JUNE 15

(9th Dhul' Hijjah)

Arafat:

Based on the schedule provided by the Ministry of hajj:

- You will depart for the Arafat Camp from Mena by bus.
- It is important to ensure you are well-rested as this day holds great significance in your Hajj journey.
- Breakfast and lunch will be provided, and throughout the day, snacks, fruits, and refreshments will be available.
- At sunset, we will transfer you to Muzdalifah based on the schedule provided by the ministry of Hajj.

SATURDAY, JUNE 15

(9th Dhul' Hijjah)

Continued

Muzdalifah:

- We will pray Maghrib and 'Isha prayers together, combining and shortening them.
- **After the Fajr prayer**, we will continue with the remaining of the Manasik and return to Mena.
- **There might be an option for some individuals to leave after midnight**, as a fatwa permits women, sick individuals, and the elderly to depart early in the morning for Mena.
- **Notes:** Please be aware that there are no tents and limited facilities in Muzdalifah.
- Additionally, please remember to collect your pebbles for the stoning (Jamaraats).

Timings and movements are determined by the Ministry's schedule and approval. We will provide updates on movements and timings as soon as we receive them.



DAY
10

SUNDAY, JUNE 16

(10th Dhul' Hijjah)

EID DAY - EID MUBARAK!

Upon your arrival in Mena, we will guide you to the **Jamaraat for the rite of Ramii (throwing pebbles at the Jamaraat-ul-Aqabah).**

Breakfast, lunch & dinner will be served. In addition, fruits and refreshments will be available throughout.

Based on the availability and schedule provided by the Ministry of hajj, In shaa Allah we will transfer you to your Aziziyah hotel and back to the camp.

Based on the timing, if you are able to, you should perform your **Tawaf El Efada**

We will provide updates on movements and timings as soon as we receive them.*

11

MONDAY, JUNE 17

(11th Dhul' Hijjah)

If you have not done your **Tawaf Al Efada**, this will be a good time for you to do so.

Based on the availability and schedule provided by the Ministry of hajj, In shaa Allah we will update you with the departure schedule.

We will guide you to the **Jamaraat** for the rite of Ramii (throwing pebbles at all three Jamaraats).

Breakfast, lunch & dinner will be served. In addition, fruits and refreshments will be available throughout.

Timings and movements are determined by the Ministry's schedule and approval. We will provide updates on movements and timings as soon as we receive them.

12

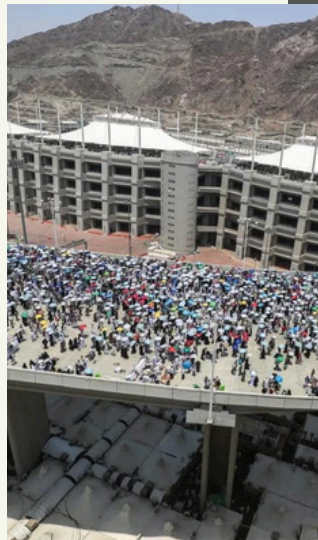
TUESDAY, JUNE 18

Tawaf Al Wada and Return Home

Your team leader will provide you with information on the departure schedule for your **Tawaf Al Wada** and to **Jeddah Airport** based on your flight itinerary.

Please ensure that you are prepared and ready for the departure process at the designated time provided.
